
Our program is so much more than 'just another dance class'. We're the whole package – from scheduled

- Excursions come along to the studio in the main street of Caloundra! We offer workshop experiences so students can immerse themselves in a real life dance studio
- Incursions a great option for centres wanting to try themed workshops on an occasional basis or over a 4 week 'mini course' (see our 'mini course' or 'workshop' options on page 8)
- School Holiday Workshops a variety of fun, themed holiday workshops perfectly suited to every budget & interest (either held at our HQ location or on site with our community partners)
- Free Holiday Workshop Program held one day each school holidays in our Caloundra HQ studios to allow community members to experience dance, drama, acrobatics and more. We often partner with local charities to support

While the focus of the classes is to have fun & develop a love of the arts, Petite Performers aims to enhance the existing preschool program utilising the Arts as a valuable learning tool by covering the following Key Learning Areas:

Outcome 1: Children have a strong sense of identity

- Children feel safe, secure, supported & confident
- Emerging autonomy, inter-dependence, resilience, self identity and sense of agency

Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world

Outcome 3: Children have a strong sense of wellbeing

- Children become strong in their social and emotional wellbeing
- Children take increasing responsibility for their own health and physical wellbeing

Outcome 4: Children are confident and involved learners

• Curiosity, cooperation, confidence, creativity, commitment, enthusiasm, persistence, imagination and reflexivity = the performing arts!

Outcome 5: Children are effective communicators

- Children interact verbally and non-verbally with others for a range of purposes
- Children engage with a range of texts and gain meaning from these texts
- Children express ideas and make meaning using a range of media







We partner with Childcare centres & Kindergartens that believe in the power of dance, drama & music. Our partnership model works in 2 ways:

- Inclusive Model We take a full class through a program with all administration & payment through the childcare centre or;
- Select Model Select students opt in for the program & the centre receives a per student fee bonus per term. This model incentivises both parties as we need approximately 20 students to run a viable program at each centre. The more enrolments, the greater the income for the centre.

How It Works:

- Petite Performers runs weekly classes on site (a choice of class style or multiple is possible)
- Petite Performers administers the entire program (with bonuses such as social media content, email marketing templates and shoutouts on our Dance Energy/ Petite Performers social pages with a combined total of 6,500+ local followers)
- The centre provides a suitable room or space
- The centre provides marketing support to help us fill classes (see below)
- Petite Performers pays a per student fee each term (for the "select" model only)
- Or Petite Performers issues the centre with an invoice once per term (for the "inclusive" model only)

The Fees:

Select Model

- 45 minute class
- \$160/term
- No enrol fee
- \$35 costume hire (end of year show - optional)

Inclusive Model

- \$120/hr at the centre/week (could be split up into 2 x 45 min sessions = \$180 etc)
- Minimum hour cost
- Single class is 45 minutes (takes into account set up etc)
- Paid via the centre (invoiced once per term)

Mini Course: Starting from \$397
